- Accepts Medicaid and many insurance plans depending on services provided, and also offers low sliding-fee scale.
- Teen Health
 - Abstinence counseling, birth control, and pregnancy testing.
 - Also offers youth advocacy, tobacco prevention education, and immunizations.
