- Hours and Services:
 - Weekdays, 6:00AM – 6:00PM; Weekends, 6:00AM – 5:30PM
 - Showers for men/women (soap, shampoo, towels are provided)
 - Newer/cleaner clothes can be earned by helping with some chores
 - Free Haircuts – Every other Monday
 - Storage facility for one bag – waitlist possible
 - Access to phone for local calls – limited long-distance availability, message board – posts guest names if they have a message
 - Use of St. Francis Center's address and phone number to receive mail, stay in touch with family, or for job or house hunting
 - Employment Office - Access to day labor jobs
 - Mental health, veterans' and medical assistance - designated days
 - Access to a caseworker who helps with a variety of needs

Daytime shelters offer a place to go during the day for those experiencing homelessness. Services offered can include meals, showers, laundry, food/clothing assistance, case management, phone services and more.
