- Methadone - Contracted with Beacon for Medicaid and self-pay; \$50 for intake, \$10 for daily dosing
- Suboxone – Only self-pay (\$200 fee upfront covers cost of medication, monitoring, dispensing for 1st four weeks of treatment)
- New patients may arrive for intake (paperwork and dosing) between 5am and 5:30am on Tue and Thurs. Patients may complete paperwork any day Mon-Fri. Walk-ins welcome.
