- Represents low and moderate taxpayers before the IRS in audit, appeals, collection issues, and federal tax litigation. Not associated with the IRS.
- Call to request an application or download it from their website
- Income limits, yearly, by family size:
  - 1 = \$29,700; 2 = \$40,050; 3 = \$50,400; 4 = \$60,750;
  - 5 = \$71,100; 6=\$81,450

A number of additional factors area also used to determine if they are able to formally represent individuals.

- Income limit: \$54,000 a year.
- Call number above or visit website to locate sites near you (changes yearly)
- *What to Bring to the VITA Site?*
  - Proof of Identification: Social Security Cards or ITINS for you, your spouse, and all dependents in your household. **MUST BRING PHOTO ID.**
  - All wage and earning statements (W-2, W-2G, 1099's etc.)
  - Any other information concerning your income and expenses for 2011
  - Bank routing number and account number for Direct Deposit
  - Copy of last year's return (if available)

The Piton Foundation: During the tax filing season, from about late January through mid April, you can go to a free tax assistance site where IRS-certified tax preparers will prepare and electronically file ("e-file") your tax return at no cost, if you earned less than \$54,000.

Some of these free tax sites are located at community colleges, and some four-year colleges, across Colorado through "Tax Help Colorado," a program sponsored by The Piton Foundation and the Colorado Community College System.
