- Investigates alleged discrimination on the basis of physical or mental disability in housing, public accommodations, and employment.
 - Must file report within 1 year of last alleged housing discrimination
 - Must file report within 60 days of last alleged public accommodation discrimination
 - Must file within 6 months of last alleged employment discrimination
- Requires filling out an intake packet and cooperating with investigation
- No representation is required or provided.
- Hours: 8:00am – 5:00pm, Monday-Friday
