What is Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP)?

The CICP provides discounted health care services to low income individuals at participating providers.

This program does not meet the mandatory health insurance requirement.

Most people in Jefferson County apply for CICP through MCPN, which is the first resource on this Onesheet.

- There is an administrative fee of \$21.68 per vaccine. Vaccine fees for adults and children vary depending on the vaccine requested and insurance coverage.
- Service will not be denied due to inability to pay for any childhood vaccine, and fees may be waived. They can bill for Medicaid, CHP+, and a number of private insurances, please check when registering.
