The Food Assistance Program

(also known as Food Stamps/SNAP) offers financial help for food to income- eligible single adults and families.

Income Limits for Eligible Food Stamp Recipients (Effective 10/1/2022 – 9/30/2023)

Household Size	Maximum Gross Monthly Income*
1	\$2,266
2	\$3,072
3	\$3,840
4	\$4,626
5	\$5,412
6	\$6,200

*Income can be alimony, child support, earned income, unearned income, Social Security, etc.
