- In person: visit your local human services office

\*If you've been denied for Health First Colorado (Medicaid) but are approved for APTC and/or CSR in your denial (tax credits and cost sharing reductions), write down the **case number and authorization number** and go online to ConnectforHealthCO.com or call 1-855-752-6749 to buy health insurance with these credits.

If ineligible for Health First Colorado (Medicaid), you may be able to purchase other Insurance through Connect for Health Colorado. <u>There are no income requirements to be eligible for Marketplace- but you may be</u> eligible for more financial assistance. See chart below:

## How to Apply:

**CONNECT** HEALT

- Must be lawfully present, a resident of Colorado, and not incarcerated to qualify.
- Open Enrollment: November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022

- Free In-person Help\*\*
  - Get Help from a Broker, Health Coverage Guide or Certified Application Counselor.
    - A Broker can help evaluate benefits and coverage based on needs, process an application and apply for financial assistance. Both guides and counselors provide education and outreach on the topic of affordable health insurance options. They can provide assistance with enrollment and the application for financial assistance to reduce cost.
  - Get Help at an Enrollment Center in Your Area.
    - They provide walk-in help from certified Brokers and Health Coverage Guides for free throughout the week. No appointment is necessary, though many can make one based on your schedule.
