### **Child Care Assistance Programs (CCAP)**

https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdhs/child-care-assistance

- CCAP provides assistance to eligible, low income Colorado families to apply for child care services from birth to age 13 (or age 19 if the child has special needs or a disability and requires childcare).
- Each county establishes its own eligibility criteria and income guidelines. Please contact the Department of Human Services in your county of residence for more information or check your eligibility online at www.colorado.gov/PEAK
  - o Applicants must agree to cooperate with Child Support Services
  - o Families can chose their own provider

  - Must be residing in Jefferson County
  - o Parents who are working, attending post-secondary education (for up to 104 weeks), GED, ESL, or Adult Basic Education (for up to one year)
  - Teen parents (up to age 21) in a high school diploma program, GED program, certificate or education program
  - Families receiving Colorado Works/TANF
- Income Guidelines by Family Size:
  - o 2 \$3,170.63 3 \$3,999.38 4- \$4,828.13 5- \$5,656.88 6- \$6,485.63
- How to Apply:
  - Contact Jefferson County CCAP at 303-271-4484 or apply in person at Jefferson County Human Services
    - Walk ins are available Monday through Friday 8:00 5:00 pm, Tuesday evenings 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm.
    - Applications can also be submitted online at www.coloradopeak.secure.force.com, by email to CCAPCustomerService@co.jefferson.co.us, or fax to 303-271-4447
- To apply, families will need to submit:
  - o Birth certificates for children
  - Proof of residence in Jefferson County
  - Proof of monthly income
  - o Proof of employment or enrollment in an education program

- Child care subsidy programs provide financial assistance to employees and military members who have children enrolled, or who will be enrolled, in licensed family care homes or child care centers.
- Children must meet the following eligibility criteria
  - Ages birth to 12 years of age (Exception: For the National Park Service children's ages must fit in the range of birth to 6 years)
  - Or, Disabled and under the age of 18
