What is a food bank?

Food banks are often non-profit, charitable organizations that distribute food to those in need.

Some food banks will only serve those living within a certain area, such as a city or county. Other food banks have no residency requirements. Many, but not all, food banks require an ID and some require other

documentation, such as a piece of mailing.

It is important to call before showing up to verify that the information has not changed.
