- Provides services for limited-income homeowners ages 60 and older living in Adams, Arapahoe, Denver, Jefferson, Clear Creek, and Gilpin Counties.
- Program focuses on older adults living safely and independently in their own homes.
- Examples include:
 - Thorough Safety Assessment
 - Install grab bars in bathroom area
 - Install handheld shower
 - Install non-slip surfaces in tub or shower
 - Repair minor electrical problems
 - Repair minor plumbing problems (i.e. running toilet, leaking faucet)
 - Repair or replace door handles or deadbolts
 - Replace thermostats
 - Replace furnace filter
 - Install/replace batteries in a smoke detector
 - Install CO detector
 - Change light bulbs
 - Repair stair treads
 - Provide night lights (plug-in)

- Emergency Repair Program and Safe Home Program
 - Eligibility requirements:
 - Individuals must reside in the five-county Metro Denver and El Paso county area (Counties served are Adams, Arapahoe, Denver, Douglas, Jefferson and El Paso)
 - Be up to date on mortgage and property taxes at your home
 - Live on a low income (see income limits below)
 - Someone in your home is elderly, a person with a disability, or a child under the age of 18.
 - Income limits:
 - 1 person household - \$71,900/year
 - 2 person household - \$82,150/year

- 3 person household - \$92,400/year
- 4 person household - \$102,650/year
- Consideration is given first to households that have not yet received any services from our organization, as well as seniors, persons with disabilities, and families with children who are unable to make their own repairs and who have no able-bodied family members to assist them.

- You must be the owner of the home (title/deed in your name) and it must be your primary residence
- Monday- Friday 8:00am – 4:30 pm
- Limited to individual residing in: Lakewood, Wheat Ridge, Golden, Mountain View, or Westminster; unincorporated Jefferson County; or another participating community in Jefferson County.
- Your total household income must be below the 80% Area Median Income (AMI) limit set by HUD (see table below). These income limits are subject to change without notice. Income guidelines are listed on website.

- Income guidelines listed on website as well as the application.
- The program offers a \$1,000 grant for emergency repairs or a \$10,000 deferred loan at zero percent for eligible home improvements.
- Applicants are limited to applying every five years and any previous loan must be paid in full.
