- Provides services for limited-income senior homeowners ages 60 and older living in Adams, Arapahoe, Denver, Jefferson, Clear Creek, and Gilpin Counites
- Program focuses on reducing falls and fire prevention
- Examples include:
  - Thorough Safety Assessment
  - Install grab bars in bathroom area
  - o Install handheld shower
  - o Install non-flip surfaces in tub or shower
  - o Repair minor electrical problems
  - o Repair minor plumbing problems (i.e. running toilet, leaking faucet)
  - o Repair or replace door handles or deadbolts
  - Replace thermostats
  - Replace furnace filter
  - Install/replace batteries in a smoke detector
  - Install CO detector
  - Change light bulbs
  - o Repair stair treads
  - Provide night lights (plug-in)

- Emergency Repair Program and Safe Home Program
  - Eligibility requirements: individuals must reside in the seven-county Denver Metro area (Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, and Jefferson.), own your own home, live on a low income, be either over age 60, a veteran, or be living with a disability or be a caregiver to someone living with a disability.
  - Income limits:
    - 1 person household \$29,400/year
    - 2 person household \$33,600/year
    - 3 person household \$37,800/year
    - 4 person household \$41,950/year
