- Provides housing and life skill classes.
- Strong faith-based program (Catholic), women of any faith accepted.
- Structured rules regarding curfew, school attendance, etc. Required to work or go to school 22 hours per week

Program for homeless pregnant women, transgender, and nonbinary individuals 18 and up

- Eligibility:
 - Residents must participate in weekly educational presentations.
 - Residents are required to work or go to school at least 20 hours per week.
 - For residents in any legal or treatment programs, adherence to their requirements is mandatory for remaining in the program.

Hope House Colorado's Residential Program offers a Christian-based, safe, stable home for teen moms and their children who are participating in our programs and who have become homeless or are living in an unsafe environment.

- The 12-bedroom home provides up to a week of respite care, up to nine months of transitional housing or up to two years of comprehensive programming.
- Also offers parenting classes, counseling, and social activities
- Eligibility:
 - Must be between the age of 15 and 20 years of age
 - Mom must give birth before 20th birthday
 - Must be a US citizen or documented resident of the US.

 - o Without other children
 - o Desire to live in a Christian (Catholic) community

A family-style Christian maternity home that provides everything a woman needs to bring her pregnancy to term and programs including budgeting, nutrition, counseling, pre- and post-natal management, parenting or adoptions options, self-esteem, decision-making and relationship skills.

- Eligibility:
 - Women may come at any point during pregnancy and/or up to 3 months post-partum, children are welcome
 - Commit to a 6-month residency in the program
 - Must be substance free for at least 6 months
 - Have no recent violent criminal charges
 - Must be able to pay or willing to obtain income to pay for residential and intake fee
 - Be willing to participate in Shannon's Hope programming
