- This clinic is for anyone who wants to ask an attorney questions regarding family law cases. This includes divorce, Allocation of Parental Responsibilities (or APR—formerly known as custody), contempt filings, modification of prior orders, etc. (both Pre and Post Decree cases)
- All "Ask an Attorney" clinics require a waiver to register which can be found on the website.
- Waivers are accepted on the day before the clinic beginning at 7:30 a.m. up until the day of the clinic at 8:30 a.m. First come, first served. Space is limited.
- After you submit your waiver, you will be provided a 30-minute time window for the attorney to call you at the phone number provided on your waiver when it is your turn.
- During the clinic you will be allowed up to 15 minutes to discuss your legal matter with the volunteer attorney (this will be strictly monitored, so please organize and have your questions prepared ahead of time to make the best use of your time).

- The clinic will focus on general divorce and child custody questions. Volunteer lawyers can answer questions about dissolution of marriage (divorce) and parental responsibility matters (child custody).

- This clinic is intended for individuals who are not represented by an attorney and is limited to a 15 to 30-minute consultation. Volunteer lawyers will not provide a second opinion on your case if you already have a lawyer.

 - By appointment only and held virtually via Webex or phone

 - You will need to leave a message, and a clinician will return your call to conduct a phone assessment. You can also apply for assistance online and have a clinician contact you.

- The Family Tree Legal Advocacy Program offers a free legal clinic for survivors of domestic violence, stalking and sexual assault where you can get legal information and guidance from an attorney regarding most family law issues.
- Services include:
 - Advice, information, and assistance with family law cases including, but not limited to, dissolution of marriage, legal separation, common law marriage, allocation of parental responsibility, and protection orders
 - Necessary paperwork is available for participants
 - Crisis intervention, advocacy, and support from a Family Tree legal advocate
 - Information and referrals to legal, community, and emergency resources
- Clinics are available twice a month in English and once a month in Spanish. Call to register and get specific information about dates, times, and locations of clinics.
