



## **Animal Haus, Pet Food Pantry**

- Mobile pet food pantry for Low income families or families experiencing temporary financial difficulties.
  - Not available for emergency food assistance
  - Must live in Denver or the surrounding areas
  - Application must be completed to be considered, you can use the website or call the number above to apply
  - Submit the completed application to: email to [petfood@animalhaus.org](mailto:petfood@animalhaus.org) or mail to Animal Haus, P.O. Box 140593 Denver, CO 80214
  - Upon food distribution or AH discretion, you must provide the following verification: Dated Proof of Low Income (documentation must be within the last three months) – food stamp, Medicaid, disability, unemployment, TANF, or foreclosure, eviction, or other document approved by AH.
  - Picture identification with Colorado residency listed (or picture ID and current utility bill in your name at Colorado residence)
  - Proof of pet ownership (rabies vaccination, spay/neuter certificate, proof of vaccinations, proof of adoption/ownership, tags/registration, copies of veterinarian records).

## **Colorado Pet Pantry**

- Helps to temporarily feed pets when families are in need of assistance.
  - There are different locations depending on the time of year. To know when and where food is available there is an ongoing calendar on the website listed above you should visit to find out where to go and when
  - Hold five monthly pet food banks in the Denver and Boulder areas
  - Food banks involved are: Bienvenidos Food Bank, Denver Inner City Parish, Sister Carmen, Community Ministry, and Jewish Family Services.
  - Clients of partnered human food banks may be eligible for pet food. Those people will be eligible to receive pet food every two months. If you just want pet food and no human food, please call this number 720.441.3111

## **Cat Care Society: Nibbles & Kibbles Program**

- Offers free cat food and cat litter to people who are experiencing temporary financial challenges. They are partnered with The JeffCO Action Center to provide vouchers. In order to be applicable you must go to the Action Center and acquire the paperwork to get the voucher.
  - Must be low income and provide at least one of the following: Letter from Welfare Social Services, Disability, Unemployment or other appropriate agencies, Copy of Social Security payments, Food Stamp, AFDC, SSI, Old Age Pension, Medicaid or other verification
  - Must also provide address information through one of the following: ID or Drivers License, Social Security Number, Lease agreement, phone bill, utility bill.
  - They will only see spayed and neutered cats
  - Once you have the voucher, bring it to the back door of the shelter on the 1<sup>st</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month and that is where you will be given the food and litter.

- Provides one bag of food once a month per animal at either shelter. To acquire you must go to the shelter location and provide proof of low income, proof of vaccinations, and proof of neutering/spaying, as well as some form of Identification.
