- Walk-in testing for HIV, hep C, and/or syphilis occurs every Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm, Ask for a Points West team member for assistance
- Phone hours for scheduling: Monday – Thursday 8:00 am – 5:00 pm
- STI testing and screening is based on a client's medical history, symptoms, and sexual behaviors. Standard testing may include: HIV, hepatitis C, syphilis, chlamydia, gonorrhea, herpes, and trichomoniasis

- Most services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on family income
- Providing \$10 incentives for HIV testing, and additional incentives may be available for HCV testing
- Accepts Medicaid and several private insurances
- If you are under the age of 18 you can receive free and confidential services

- Hours: Monday 8:30 am – 5pm, Tuesday – Friday 7:45 am – 5:00 pm, please see the website for clinic closures
- Anonymous and confidential STD and HIV testing; must present a photo ID at time of appointment
- Free STD and HIV testing is always available for people 18 years old and younger
- For persons without insurance and over age 19, cost of testing will be \$20-\$90 based on sliding scale
- Fees for adults over 19 will depend on services provided, fees are based on a sliding scale from \$0-90
- Medicaid, private insurance, cash, and major credit/debit cards accepted, but no one will be turned away for inability to pay
- Clinic offers appointments for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP), call for more information
- Spanish speaking services available
