- Provides on demand, door to door transportation through a shared ride service.
- If you call to request a ride
  - Phone lines are open Monday through Friday 8:00 am – 4:30 pm
  - You will need the exact address of your destination
  - Rides can be scheduled 1-7 days before it is needed; Same day rides may be available
  - You will be notified immediately during the call if your request can be fulfilled
- If you submit a ride request online:
  - Online requests are available 24 hours a day
  - You must submit your request at least 4 days in advance

### **City of Lakewood – Lakewood Rides**

- Offers rides to seniors (60+) or individuals with disabilities for grocery shopping, Volunteers of America dining sites, medical appointments and other personal needs.
- On Demand Rides: \$6 round trip for a destination within the Lakewood city limits and \$8 round trip for a destination outside of the Lakewood city limits
  - A half price fare is available to those with a monthly income below \$1,011 for an individual and \$1,371 for a couple
    - Must submit an application (available online) and proof of income to qualify
- Grocery Shopping: \$3 round trip
- Volunteers of America dining site: no charge for transportation to this event at the Clements Community Center.

### **Omnibus – City of Littleton**

- Services is by appointment only and 48 hours' notice is required (no same day transportation)
- Individuals must be a resident within the city limits of Littleton and be 55+ or disabled.
  - All transportation must be within the city limits of Littleton (only exception is medical appointments in Englewood)
- Omnibus runs Monday through Friday between 8:00 and 2:00 pm
- Ride Priorities
  - Medical appointments are given first priority
  - Grocery shopping
  - Hair and barber
  - Other activities by appointment as seating permits

  - Provides a variety of other assistance services, as well.
  - Need to be a member to receive services. If unable to afford the membership fees inquired about sliding fee scales that may be offered.
