  - Offsite Storage Hours

    - Storage access is not yet available on weekends
- Storage
  - Storage is limited to personal belongings that will fit into a 30-gallon plastic bag
  - New storage spaces are given out on a first-come, first-served basis
  - Storage must be renewed every 30 days
- Mail: (Must be enrolled in their system – can completed this same-day)
  - Anyone may receive mail at SFC. A government-issued photo ID is required to pick-up mail. Mail is kept for 7 days, after which time is it returned to its sender
- Social Services: Assistance with navigating homelessness (Wed only 9:30am-11am )
- Newer/cleaner clothes can be earned by helping with some chores
- Access to phone for local calls – limited long-distance availability, message board – posts guest names if they have a message, cell phone charging
